Do you have a vehicle you no longer want? We'll gratefully take it off your hands.

Vehicle Donation

Crawford County Commission on Aging has partnered with Meals On Wheels Association of America and the Melwood Charity Car Donation Center to manage and operate our program.

While the program is national in scope, the proceeds from your vehicle donation will benefit your local community. All you have to do is select the affiliate of your choice (choose MI Crawford County Commission on Aging) when making your donation. You can donate your used vehicle - whether operational or not - seven days a week, 24 hours a day.

What You Can Donate

We accept the donation of cars, trucks, motorcycles and RVs. They will also take boats, jet skis, and snowmobiles on road worthy trailers. As a rule, all vehicles are accepted that possess a state issued title. You must have a title for both the vehicle and trailer. A friendly towing company will pick up your donated vehicle normally within 48 hours, free of charge.

Free Pick-Up and More

For your convenience, we've made the vehicle donation process as easy as can be:

- Free towing, regardless of the vehicle's age or condition.
- No more hassles with repairing, advertising, and selling your vehicle.
- Qualify for an IRS tax deduction.
- The proceeds from your vehicle donation are channeled directly to the Crawford County Commission on Aging programs and services.
